We reply to candidates within 3 working days with an Acceptance Letter, a Purchase Letter. Candidates will have a maximum of 20 days to sign them and make the payment of the course.

After we receive the signed documents and the payment, candidates are officially students. We send them the Enrollment Letter, necessary for the visa. Now they will be able to request and obtain it upto 10 days prior to the departure.



F.A.Q.S

What is the number of available seats?

As MD Academy favors quality over quantity, we wish to ensure the best possible learning experience for our students. Therefore, a maximum of 30 students per course will be admitted for each intake (for a total of 90 students per intake, if we include all courses available at the moment).

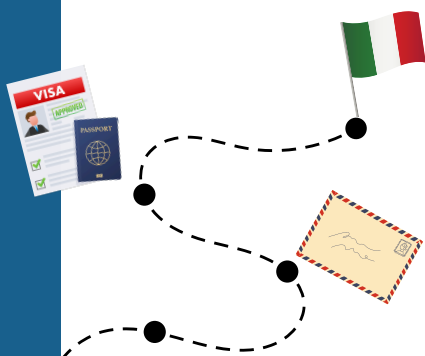
What if the maximum number of students is reached? Will I be left out?

Not at all! In such a case, your application will still be considered completely valid and you will be automatically eligible for admission in our next intake.

What if I cannot meet the payment deadline?

In such a case, MD Academy will evaluate the individual's specific situation and, on a case-by-case basis, the Admission Committee may decide to render them eligible for admission in the next intake.

However, in case of failure to meet the payment deadline for a second time, the admission will be cancelled and any fee that has already been deposited will not be refundable.

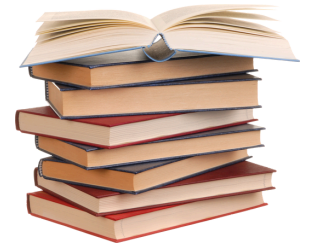

F.A.Q.S

How difficult is it to learn Italian?

That depends on a few factors. For example,

- you will be at an advantage if you are used to speaking more than one language, or have learned a foreign language in the past.
- it will be much easier for you if you already know a language with Latin roots (such as: Spanish, French, Portuguese, Brazilian, Romanian).
- Italian is a “close cousin” of Germanic languages, such as English, German, Dutch and Scandinavian languages, so knowing one of these languages is a plus. As a matter of fact, the Foreign Service Institute (FSI) considers Italian to be one of the easiest languages for English speakers to learn.

When does the course take place?

The course schedule is based (among other factors) on the availability of the majority of our students. We are aware many go to work/university during the day and we always do our best to create the most convenient schedule for everyone.

You can expect about 4 to 5 lessons per week. Each lesson lasts about 3 hours.





Getting a work visa

Recently, the Italian government has passed a law that allows students enrolled in a vocational course to easily **convert their study visa into a work visa**.

This is sending a strong, clear message:

Italy is facing a **manpower crisis** due to a much too wide gap between offer and demand. Managers, entrepreneurs and employers struggle to find enough workers to fulfill their open positions.

Italy is a treasure trove of work and study opportunities, and conversely, international skilled workers can be the answer to the emergency that is currently deeply affecting the Italian labour market.
